Request loudspeaker unit at once (CO 1st Bn). 1046 Gol Crabill directed Capt Callaghan that there is an excellent spot for obser-1055 vation near Co L and he wants an OP established there.

Coordinated attack is to be launched at hour to be announced by Div - probably 1110 about 1200. Bombing will precede attack.

1230 Loudspeaker unit arrived at C.P.

1302 All Bn lines have gone out.

Lt Magill reported some 88 positions and enemy strongpoints the locations of 1312 which were given him by a French surveyor. The arty is going to try to knock out these positions.

1st Bn reports their line extends from 825117 left flank, to 831122 right flank. 1330 Co C on left, Co B on right Co A in reserve. 3rd Bn connects on 1st Bn right

flank and extends right to 833132.

Lines are back in to all Bns. 1337

Col Crabill directed Bns to notify him when they are ready to jump off. 1338

Arty reports enemy 4 gun arty battery destroyed at 81001312. Arty preparation preceding attack will continue for 20 minutes. 1345

Col Crabill directed Major Speedie to have Co L maintain contact with Co B on 1350 their left.

The indiscriminate firing of .50 cal weapons at aerial targets especially at 1105 night must be discontinued at once. Aerial targets will be engaged by troops other than anti-aircraft troops only in cases of actual strafing and then only at effective range (MACON).

I & R reports OP has been established in front of Co L. It is possible to ob-1420

serve St Malo from there.

Bn closed in assembly area 1245 at 833115 (CO 1st Bn). 11:30

Col Crabill directed 1st Bn that they must have every weapon firing intially. 1140 He directed that they send in a fire plan as soon as possible but to be sure to check that every weapon is in position before submitting the fire plan.

Arty will begin preparation at about 1515. 1st and 3rd Bns will jump off at 1500 about 1530 or 1535. 1st and 3rd Bns are to be prepared to move across bomb line at 1515. Bomb line will be used as LD. No definite information has been received on bombing. Arty will put down red smoke at end of preparation.

Rec'd ovly from 2nd Bn showing front lines of Co's and location of Bn CP.

1502 Col Crabill directed Capt Sharpe to have his Bn on the alert in case we have to 1510 use them today.

# 7 AUGUST 1944

Enemy gum moved into position early this morning among houses at 81550985. Be-0860 lieved to be 80mm (Magill & Berner I&R).

1st and 3rd Bns jumped off on time at 0730 after an arty preparation. 1st Bn is 0805 moving in a column of Co's with leading Co at 820131. 3rd Bn has been unable to move due to heavy arty and mortar fire from St Joseph Hill.

0820 Gol Grabill went to 2nd Bn.

Arty is going to shoot some heavy stuff in on the Citadel outside St Servan. 0810 0850

General Macon directs that we put arty fire down on St Joseph Hill to try to reduce some of the enemy arty up there.

Request permission to fire on target located in houses at 82251530. Houses are 0935 on boundry. Reply in clear. (CO 331st).

(To: CO 3rd Bn) Water point 873105 (CO 329th).

0951 1000 Received sketch of St Malo, Dinard and St Servan indicating certain known defenses.

3rd Bn is getting heavy mortar, arty and MG fire. They are unable to move ahead. 1013 They have taken several prisoners this morning but are unable to get them back to the rear.

Col Crabill returned to C.P. 1015

Col Grabill reports that 3rd Bn had a pretty tough time last night. They received 1016 several heavy counterattacks during the night and were quite disorganized this morning.

(CO 331st) 82251530 not in Blackjack come. (CO 329th). 1017 Capt Sharpe was directed to alert his Bn for a movement and then report to CP. 1038

Capt Sharpe reported in to Col Crabill. 1052

3rd Bn reports that a plat of Germans has come in on their left flank. Col Cra-1100 bill thinks it is a plat of 1st Bn as they were going to move in that direction. 3rd Bn was directed to check closely to determine if it is enemy or 1st Bn troops. Capt Sharpe was directed to put out patrols before starting his move around 1st Bn.

1110 3rd Bn says troops coming in on their left flank are definitely enemy troops. 1112

They (3rd Bn) are receiving fire from both flanks.

3rd Bn reports they are unable to move ahead due to heavy mortar and arty fire.

Tanks are being sent up to support 1st Bn.

1355 Received overlay showing Co fronts of 1st Bn and Co F. Co's E and G passing 1430 around left flank.

General Macon directs that we move ahead. He said to put all available arty into 1450

1st Bn is to jump off during serenade at 1730.

1705 Unit on our right withdrawn (CO 3rd Bn). 1808

knemy arty fire being directed on our position from high point on our left (3rd Bn) 1820

Bn CP located at 829122 (CO 1st Bn).

At least 3 pillboxes around Citadel have been knocked out and AA guns on top of Citadel have been knocked out. Openings and tunnels leading into Citadel are covered by MC's and flame throwers. Every time one of these is knocked out, another moves into the position and takes over. After troops got inside wall MG's opened up on them. Col Crabill directs that TD's keep firing and try to knock out any observed pillbox.



When 1st Bn tried to get up on Citadel on 15 Aug, they were held down by MG and 2130 then enemy mortars started searching them out. Major Speedie states that we must get upon Citadel in a large force in order to stay there. Capt Bagley suggests that we keep TD's and 57's constantly covering each enemy gun position until our troops are almost up to positions. If the tanks can get up, they will fire direct fire at the walls and slits in wals. The Engrs will make preparations to blow rail obstacles to make it possible for tanks to go up. The attack will take place between 1600 and 1800. Emergency signal for lifting arty will be green pyrotechnic flare. Yellow flare will be signal for lifting TD fire. Fire at least 2 or 3 flares so they can be observed.

### 17 AUGUST 1944

Bombing mission on Citadel has been reduced to 24 planes. 1200

General Macon came to CP. 1210

Bombing on Citadel will take place at 1500. 1300

Arty observer reports 2 white flags went up at Citadel and some enemy started 1420 coming out but a couple of shells landed close and they went back into fort. All firing on Citadel is being ceased and loudspeaker truck is resuming broadcasting.

It is reported that 5 Germans came out on top of Citadel but went into another 1430 dugout. It is reported that several of them are running around from dugout to dugout.

About 10 Germans comming from Citadel with white flag - a few still coming out. 11:52

4 Germans came all way down the hill - 16 came part of the way. 1453

General Macon ordered planes to bomb Cezembre island instead of Citadel. Capt 1455

Bagley notified air liaison to direct planes of changes.

Bombers were contacted and are going to bomb Gezembre. They are still circling Citadel to await confirmation of surrender. It is reported that 605 Germans 1459 have surrendered (unconfirmed) at Citadel. 10 of our men who were prisoners in Citadel brought out this report of the surrender.

It is reported that several (about 30) of our troops are up on Citadel. One 1520 American who was a German prisoner states that Germans started breaking and destraying arms and equipment 21 hours ago. Germans cried with joy when order to surrender and destroy weapons was given. They still have not started coming out. Planes can keep circling for about 20 minutes until surrender is confirmed.

3rd Bn S-1 is in Citadel now and has sent back for men to receive prisoners. 1530

3rd Bn closed into assembly area at 1630. Location - coordinates: 49862815, 1130 NOHD OST 107 1:50,000 (00 3rd Bn - 1655 - 28 Aug 1944).

It is reported that there have been indications during the past few days that 2200 enemy may possibly be withdrawing from positions across the Loire River.

## 30 AUGUST 1944

It is reported that 3 enemy ammunition dumps across the Loire were blown up during 0915 the night. The cause has not been determined. 1 French ammunition dump in vicinity of 2nd Bn was blown up late last night. It is believed the cause was a defective grenade or mine.

1000 2230

Report received from T/Sgt Berner, 329th I&R plat at 2200, 30 Aug 1944: Six prisoners, four of them German and two French impressed into the German army, were captured on the south side of the Leire River tonight at St Remy La Varenne. One was identified as being with the 10th Company of the 453 Regt. This German had with him a centrel book containing the following route: August 30th; Doue La Fontane, Montreuil Bellay, Loudon, Richelieu, Bretagne, Bourges, FFI patrols report no enemy in Saumur proper. An agent of Sgt Berner reports that: No enemy north of a line running generally from La Fontenelle, Brissac, Gennes, Saumur. Line from Gennes to Saumur runs generally one mile away from and parallel to the Loire River. No enemy left on islands of Blaison and Belle. They left between 1900 and 2100 this evening. These islands are in the Loire River, SE of Angers. General Von Klaus left tonight from Grezille (0-9762). The population of Grezille say the Germans are going to Loudon. Sgt Berner says that miscellaneous reports received from the FFI concerning towns from which the Germans have left verify the report made by the above mentioned agent.

2300 All reports indicate that enemy is making a general withdrawal from their positions

on the other side of Loire River.

#### 31 AUGUST 1944

Request that SETREP overlays be made from maps, seeles one Upon Div order, 1st Bn is moving to a new assembly area in the vicinity of Chateau 0830

I & R platoon reports they have made contact with Co L, 137th Inf, to the east at Orleans. Contact has been maintained with 331st Inf to the west. The Rrench 1700 sent large patrols across Loire River at Pont De Ce, finding no enemy in the immediate area.
