1. 19 Nov '44 - 1000 - The men guarding the Artillery Observation Post at I017388 (Map, Central Europe, 1/100,000 Sheet T-1) saw a German patrol of 5-6 men, and fired on the patrol which withdrew carrying one of their wounded, without returning the fire.
