I--AWARD OF SILVER STAR MEDAL--Under the provisions of AR 600-45 and in accordance with authority contained in paragraph 2a, Section I, Circular No. 6, Headquarters Third U. S. Army, 26 April 1944, the Silver Star Medal is awarded to the following:

CHARLES W. SCHMITT, JR., O-1299634, First Lieutenant, Infantry, ***th Infantry, United States Army. For gallantry in action on 27 July 1944, near *****, France. Despite heavy enemy machine gun, mortar and artillery fire, Lieutenant Schmitt after making two personal reconnaissance trips to determine the proper method of attack against strongly defended enemy pillboxes and houses, led a tank destroyer into full view of the enemy and personally directed effective fire upon the positions. Acting with inspired initiative and determination he then led the assault on the positions, captured them and thereby enabled the battalion to continue its advance. Lieutenant Schmitt's outstanding courage, tactical ability and devotion to duty reflect the highest credit upon himself and the finest traditions of the military service. Entered military service from New York.

ROBERT G. NAPIER, 6669777, Sergeant, (then Private First Class), Infantry, ***th Infantry, United States Army. For gallantry in action during the period 9 July 1944 to 11 July 1944, near *****, France. Sergeant Napier while serving as a member of the anti-tank platoon armed himself with a rocket launcher and together with another man joined the front line companies as a tank-hunter team. Disregarding his own safety despite intense enemy artillery and small arms fire he made his way to within striking distance of two enemy tanks that were firing upon the rifle companies and demobilized them. This daring action enabled the line companies to reach their objective. Sergeant Napier's cool and courageous determination to meet the enemy and destroy him reflect the highest credit upon himself and the finest traditions of the military service. Entered military service from Kentucky.

II--AWARD OF BRONZE STAR--Under the provisions of AR 600-45, as amended by letter, Hq ETOUSA AG 200.6 LT, subject: "Bronze Star Medal", 27 February 1944 and in accordance with the authority contained in paragraph 2a, Section I, Circular No. 6 Hq Third United States Army, 26 April 1944, the Bronze Star is awarded to the following:

HASSELL S. BAYNES, 34895686, Private First Class, Infantry, ***th Infantry, for distinguishing himself by heroic achievement in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States. Entered Military Service from North Carolina.

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THOMAS N. FENFIELD, 3449742, Private First Class, Infantry, ****th Infantry, for distinguishing himself by heroic achievement in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States. Entered Military Service from Tennessee.

JUNIOR C. BRINKLEY, 3967612, Private First Class, Infantry, ****th Infantry, for distinguishing himself by heroic achievement in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States. Entered Military Service from Washington.

WILLIAM M. CAIMAN, 0-26120, First Lieutenant, Corps of Engineers, ****th Engineer Battalion, for distinguishing himself by heroic achievement in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States. Entered United States Military Academy from Washington, D. C.

JOHNNIE B. CONLEY, 35671318, Private First Class, Infantry, ****th Infantry, for distinguishing himself by heroic achievement in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States. Entered Military Service from Kentucky.


