FRANCE:

TANKS AND INFANTRY OF THE BRITISH SECOND ALMY HAVE CROSSED THE STRONG ALBERT CANAL IN THE VICINITY OF BEEKINGES AND WERE LAST HEPORTED ABOUT 5 MILES PAST THE CANAL AND VITHIN 25 MILES OF THE GERMAN BORDER. THE BRIDGEHEAD HAS ALKEADY BEEN ENLARGED SINCE YESTERDAY. GERMAN OPPOSITION WAS DESCRIBED AS 'TIGHT', THE NAZIS HAD MANAGED TO BRING UP SOME INFANTRY REINFORCEMENTS FROM HOLLAND BUT THE BRITISH BROKE THROUGH THE GERMAN DEFENSES. THE GERMANS WERE REPORTED TO BE RETIRING IN GOOD ORDER. DUTCH CONTINGENTS ARE FIGHTING ALONGSIDE OF THE BRITISH. THE AMERICAN FIRST ARMY HAS STRONG INFANTRY AND TANK FORCES IN THE VICINITY OF LIEGE IN BELGIUM. YANK TROOPS WERE REPORTED A BOUT 20 MILES FROM THE GERMAN BORDER IN THIS VILINITY. THE FIRST ARMY IS HEADING DOWN THE ROAD BETWEEN NAMUE AND LIEGE. THIS HOAD HUNS INTO AACHEN IN GERMANY. GERMAN RESISTANCE AROUND THE ALLIED BRIDGEHEADS OVER THE MEUSE HAS BEEN STIFFENING AND THE TROOPS OF THE YANK FIRST ARMY WHO ARE PUSHING THROUGH THE FOREST OF THE ARDENNES ARE RUNNING INTO CONSIDE HABLE OPPOSITION. THE LARGE TOWN OF SEDAN HAS BEEN LIBERATED BY THE YANK FIRST ARMY. SEDAN IS VERY IM-PORTANT FOR IT IS A HINGE POSITION OF THE MAGINOT LINE. THE GERMANS OUTFLANKED THE MAGINOT LINE IN 1940 WHEN THEY CAPTURED SEDAN. GENERAL PATTON'S THIRD ARMY NOW HOLD THE WESTERN BANK OF THE MOSELLE RIVER FOR 50 MILES. PATTON'S FORCES HAVE TWO BRIDGEHEADS OVER THE MOSELLE A BOUT HALF WAY BETWEEN NANCY AND METZ. THERE IS HEAVY FIGHTING TAKING PLACE IN THE AREA OF NANCY. AMERICAN TROOPS HAD CAPTURED PART OF NANCY BUT THE GERMANS TOOK IT BACK. THE GERMANS HAVE A STRONG DEFENSIVE SCREEN IN THE MOSELLE GAP BUT GENERAL PATTON HAS PUT TANKS AND INFANTRY ACROSS THE MOSELLE AT HIS TWO BRIDGEHEADS.

TODAY, BRITISH LANCASTERS AGAIN PASTED IE HAVKE WITH HUGE BOMBS. HARD FIGHTING IS DEVELOPING FOR THE CHANNEL PORTS. CANADIANS ARE CLOSING IN ON BOTH CALAIS AND BOULCONE DESPITE A TORRENTIAL HAIN. THE NAZI BELT OF LONG HANGE GOASTAL GUNS IS BETWEEN CALAIS AND BOULOGNE AND THERE IS EVERY SIGN THAT THE GERMANS WILL BATTLE FIERCELY FOR THE COASTLINE. CANADIANS CLOSING IN ON DUNKERQUE HAVE IL BERATED THE TOWN OF ROULERS. LAST NIGHT, MOSQUITO BOMBERS HIT TARGETS NORTH OF ANTWERP AND GHENT IN BELGIUM.

IN EASTERN FRANCE, AMERICAN TROOPS HAVE REACHED BESANCON ABOUT 50 MILES FROM THE BEIFORT GAP. THE GERMANS HAD A 20 MILE DEFENSE LINE BEFORE BESANCON BUT THE YANKS BROKE THROUGH INTO THE CITY. THE GERMANS ARE PUTTING UP HEAVY RESISTANCE IN THIS AREA IN AN EFFORT TO PROTECT THEIR LINES OF RETREAT. HEAVY RAIN HAS SLOWED THE FIGHTING DOWN SOME HAT. FRENCH TROOPS ARE MEETING STIFF OPPOSITION NEAR DIJON. ALLIED FORCES OPERATING NEAR THE SWISS BORDER HAVE CAPTURED THE TOWN OF PONTARLIER.

RUSSIA:

RED ARMY THOPS EXPECT TO LINK UP WITH MARSHALL TITO'S FORCES IN YUGOSLAVIA SOON. THE RUSSIANS ARE JUST ACROSS THE RIVER FROM SERBIA AND THERE ARE REPORTS THAT ALL OF SERBIA HAS RISEN IN OPEN REVOLT. YESTERDAY, THE RUSSIANS TOOK ANOTHER 3000 PRISONERS IN RUMANIA AND CONTINUED THEIR MOPPING UP. THE SOVIET FORCES HAVE PUSHED DEEPER INTO THE TRANSYLVANIA ALPS. THE RUMANIAN RADIO HAS ANNOUNCED THAT RUMANIA IS AT WAR WITH HUNGARY. THE BULGARIAN GOVERNMENT HAS ANNOUNCED THAT ALL PRISONERS RELONGING TO THE ALLED NATIONS WILL BE FREED. NORTHEAST OF WARSAW IN POLAND, THE REDS HAVE CAPTURED SEVERAL MORE PLACES. THE WAZIS ARE BRINGING UP MORE TANK AND INFANTRY FORCES IN THIS SECTOR.

MARSHALL TITO'S FORCES IN THE LAST 6 DAYS HAVE OUT ALL THE MAIN RAILAOAD LINES IN YUGOSLAVIA. PATRIOTS HAVE OUT THE COMMUNICATION LINES RUNNING TO ITALY IN 600 PLACES. TITO'S MENTARE BEING HELPED IN THEIR FIGHT BY ALLIED TROOPS KNOWN AS "LAND FORCES ADRIATIC." ALLIED PLANES AND AN ALLIED FIELT OFF THE COAST HAVE JOINED THE LAND FORCES IN AN ALL OUT OFFENSIVE ON GERMAN COMMUNICATIONS IN YUGOSLAVIA. THE SITUATION OF THE GERMAN FORCES IN THE SOUTHERN BALKANS IS GETTING STRADILY WORSE. ALL ROADS AND COMMUNICATION LINES ARE BEING BLASTED. GERMAN CHANCES OF GETTING BACK TO GERMANY ARE VERY SMALL.

IT .. LY :

BAD WEATHER HAS SLOWED DOWN FIGHTING AND FLYING IN ITALY. THE BAITISH EIGHTH ARMY IS ENGAGED IN FIERCE AND CONFUSED FIGHTING NEAR KIMINI. THE GERMANS MADE SEVERAL COUNTERATTACKS IN THIS AREA YESTERDAY BUT ALL ATTACKS WERE HEATEN OFF. INLAND FROM RIMINI, BRITISH TROOPS ARE ENGAGED IN HEAVY FIGHTING NORTH OF THE GONCA RIVER. HEAVY AND MEDIUM BOMBERS WERE GROUNDED BY BAD WEATHER YESTERDAY BUT FIG-HTERS AND FIGHTER BOMBERS WERE OUT OVER NORTHERN ITALY AND ALSO OVER YUGOSLAVIA IN SUPPORT OF TITO'S FORCES. NORTHWEST OF FLORENCE, THE AMERICAN FIFTH ARMY IS IN CONTACT WITH THE OUTPOSTS OF THE GOTHIC LINE.

ENGL AND:

MORE THAN 1000 HEAVY AMERICAN BOMBERS ESCORTED BY LARGE NUMBERS OF MUSTANG FIGHTERS TODAY BLASTED OIL SUPPLIES AND TANK FACTORIES IN THE LUDWIGSHAFEN AND FRANKFORT AREAS OF GERMANY. LAST NIGHT, MOSQUITO BOMBERS HIT KARLSRUHE.

PACIFIC:

AMERICAN SUPER FORTS TODAY BLASTED JAPANESE TAKGETS IN MANCHUKIA. THE JAP HADIO SAID THAT THE BOMBERS CAME FROM CHINA. THE ALLIES NOW HAVE COMPLETE AIR MASTERY OVER THE MALACCA ISLANDS BETWEEN NEW GUINEA AND THE PHILLIPINES. HALMAHERA ISLAND WAS AGAIN POUNDED. MINDANAO ISLAND IN THE PHILLIPINES AND PALAU, THE NAVAL BASE IN THE CAROLINES, WERE AGAIN ATTACKED BY AMERICAN BOMBERS. IN BURMA, THE 36TH BRITISH DIVISION HAS PUSHED ON FOR ANOTHER 10 MILES ON THE ROAD TO MANDALAY.
