FRANCE:

THE AMERICAN FIRST ARMY HAS DRIVEN A BREACH SIX MILES WIDE AND SIX MILES DEEP INTO THE SIEGFRIED LINE NORTH OF AACHEN. AMERICAN ARMOR HAS BEEN THROWN INTO THE BREACH TO EXPLOIT THE BREAKTHROUGH. CORRESPONDENTS AT ALLIED HEADQUARTERS SAY THAT THE BREAKTHROUGH IS A MAJOR ONE. BOTH NORTH AND SOUTH OF THE TOWN OF AIX-LA-CHAPPELLE AMERICAN FIRST ARMY TROOPS HAVE DRIVEN INTO THE SIEGFRIED LINE. AMERICAN DIVE BOMBERS POUNDED THE ENEMY DEFENSES AND THEN THE INFANTRY WENT IN. SOUTH OF AACHEN, OTHER FIRST ARMY TROOPS HAVE ADVANCED AND THE CITY OF AACHEN ITSELF IS NOW DEEPLY OUTFLANKED. SOUTHEAST OF AACHEN YANK FIRST ARMY TROOPS ARE CLOSING IN ON THE TOWN OF HURTGEN. GENERAL PATTON'S THIRD ARMY TROOPS TODAY LAUNCHED A NEW OFFENSIVE BETWEEN NANCY AND METZ ON A 50 MILE FRONT. TANKS AND INFANTRYMEN SPEARHEADED THE NEW ATTACK AND CORRESPONDENTS SAY THAT THE ATTACK IS GOING WELL.

CANADIAN TROOPS ARE FIGHTING A DESPERATE BATTLE WITH GERMANS ON THE FAR SIDE OF THE IEOPOLD CANAL. THE CANADIANS ARE CLOSING ON THE ROAD THAT LINKS THE ISLANDS OF THE SCHELDT ESTUARY WITH THE MAINLAND. FURTHER NORTH, UNITED KINGDOM TROOPS HAVE BEATEN OFF GERMAN COUNTERATTACKS NEAR TILBURG. THERE HAS BEEN NO CHANGE IN THE FIGHTING ON THE SECOND ARMY SALIENT OTHER THAN BRITISH TROOPS HAVE BEATEN OFF ANOTHER COUNTERATTACK AT THE TIP OF THE SALIENT. THE GERMANS ARE REGROUPING THEIR FORCES IN THE ARNHEM AREA IN ANTICIPATION OF A LARGE SCALE BRITISH OFFENSIVE IN THAT AREA SOON. THE ALLIED SEVENTH ARMY HAS BEEN FORCED TO GIVE UP SOME GROUND NEAR BELFORT IN THE FACE OF FIERCE GERMAN COUNTERATTACKS.

MORE THAN 5000 ALLIED PLINES FROM BASES IN ENGLAND, FRANCE, ITALY, BELGIUM, HOLLAND AND LUXEMBOURG YESTERDAY LAUNCHED THE BIGGEST AERIAL ASSAULT OF THE WAR ON GERMANY AND THE OCCUPIED COUNTRIES. THE AMERICANS LOST 51 HEAVY BOMBERS AND 15 FIGHTERS DURING YESTERDAY'S ATTACK. THE GREAT GERMAN INDUSTRIAL TRIANGLE OF COLOGNE, DUSSELDORF AND AACHEN WAS HEAVILY HIT DURING THE ATTACK YESTERDAY.

RUSSIA:

RUSSIAN FORCES ARE DRIVING WESTWARD ACROSS THE PLAINS OF HUNGARY AND HAVE REACHED A POINT ONLY 80 MILES FROM BUDAPEST. THE RUSSIANS TOOK MORE THAN 300 TOWNS AND VILLAGES YESTERDAY AND HAVE REACHED THE EASTERN BANK OF THE RIVER TISZA. ANOTHER RED SPEARHEAD IS LESS THAN 30 MILES FROM THE HUNGARIAN BORDER NEAR WHERE THE THREE COUNTRIES OF ROMANIA, HUNGARY AND YUGOSLAVIA LINK UP. THE GERMANS SAY THAT VIOLENT FIGHTING IS GOING ON NEAR THE TISZA RIVER. MARSHALL TITO'S YUGOSLAV PATRIOTS HAVE REACHED THE HUNGARIAN BORDER ON A FRONT OF 20 MILES.

THE GERMANS ADMIT THAT THE RUSSIANS ARE ADVANCING IN LITHUANIA.

ITALY:

MORE THAN 800 AMERICAN HEAVY BOMBERS FROM ITALY TOOK PART IN THE GREAT AIR BLOW DEALT GERMANY YESTERDAY. ALLIED FIGHTERS AND FIGHTER BOMBERS WERE ALSO OUT BOMBING GERMAN GUN POSITIONS IN ITALY YESTERDAY. AMERICAN FIFTH ARMY TROOPS ARE LESS THAN 12 MILES FROM BOLOGNE. IN GREECE, MOST OF THE SOUTHERN PART OF THE MAINLAND IS NOW CLEARED OF NAZIS. BRITISH TROOPS ARE ADVANCING TOWARDS CORINTH.

PACIFIC:

TWO HUNDRED AMERICAN HEAVY BOMBERS YESTERDAY ATTACKED THE JAP BASE OF RABAU ON NEW BRITAIN. JAPANESE DEFENSES BEFORE TIDDIM ARE UNDER VERY HEAVY AIR BOMBARDMENT.

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE GAME:

THE CARDS SCORED TWO RUNS IN THE FIRST WHEN WITH ONE OUT HOPP SINGLED. MUSIAL THE NEXT BATTER THEN HIT THE FIRST PITCHED BALL FOR A HOME RUN. COOPER GROUNDED OUT AND SANDERS FANNED.

THE CARDS SCORED TWO MORE RUNS IN THE THIRD WHEN LITWHILER SCORED WITH ONE OUT. HOPP THEN STRUCK OUT. MUSIAL SINGLED AND LITWHILER WENT TO SECOND. COOPER THEN SINGLED SCORING LITWHILER, MUSIAL WENT TO SECOND. SANDERS HIT TO GUTTERIDGE AT SECOND AND GUTTERIDGE ERRED AND MUSIAL SCORED AS COOPER WENT TO THIRD. KUROWSKI GROUNDED OUT.

IN THE SIXTH INNING THE CARDS SCORED AGAIN WHEN SANDERS SINGLED. KUROWSKI THEN STRUCK OUT BUT MARION DOUBLED SCORING SANDERS. BURBAN FLIED OUT AND BRECHEEN GROUNDED OUT.

THE BROWNS SCORED THEIR ONLY RUN IN THE EIGHTH WHEN MOORE WALKED. STEPHENS THEN SINGLED SENDING MOORE TO THIRD. LAABS HIT INTO A DOUBLE PLAY MARION TO BURBAN TO SANDERS. MOORE SCORED ON THE PLAY. MC QUINN GROUNDED OUT.
