### GERMANY:

AMERICAN FIRST ARMY TROOPS SMASHING FORWARD THROUGH SLEET AND SNOW HAVE FOUGHT THEIR WAY TO WITHIN A MILE OF THE BIG CITY OF DUKEN. THE YANKS DROVE FOR A MILE ACROSS MUDDY GROUND AND BROKE INTO 2 SMALL TOWNS ONLY  $\frac{1}{2}$  MILE FROM THE ROER RIVER AND WITHIN A MILE OF DUREN. ANOTHER FIRST ARMY FORCE HAS REACHED THE WESTERN BANK OF THE ROER AT THREE PLACES SOUTH OF DUREN AND HOLD A MILE OF THE WESTERN BANK OF THE RIVER. THERE ARE SIGNS THAT THE GERMANS ARE MAKING A GENERAL WITH-DRAWAL TO THE EAST BANK OF THE RIVER IN THE DUREN SECTOR. THE YANKS HAVE TAKEN 7 TOWNS SINCE OPENING THEIR OFFENSIVE 2 DAYS AGO. AMERICAN FIGHTER BOMBERS MADE IN-TENSIFIED BOMBINGS OF THE DUREN AREA YESTERDAY.

IN THE SAAR VALLEY, AMERICAN THIRD ARMY TROOPS HAVE MADE ANOTHER CROSSING OF THE GERMAN FRONTLER NEAR SAARGUEMINES. TROOPS OF THE AMERICAN SEVENTH ARMY AFTER TAK-ING THE TOWN OF HAGENAU IN NORTHERN ALSACE YESTERDAY HAVE RAPIDLY DRIVEN FORMARD ON A 20 MILE FRONT TO THE EAST OF THE TOWN AND ARE PUSHING DOWN TWO IMPORTANT RAIL LINES LEADING INTO GERMANY. THE YANKS WERE LAST REPORTED LESS THAN 5 MILES FROM THE GERMAN BORDER NEAR THE RHINE RIVER OPPOSITE THE BIG GERMAN INDUSTRIAL CITY OF KARLSRUHE. GERMAN RESISTANCE ON THIS SECTOR SEEMS TO BE CRACKING. FURTHUR SOUTH, OTHER, MERICAN FORCES IN ALSACE ARE STEADILY NARHOWING THE ALSACE BRIDGENEAD.

THE THEMENDOUS AERIAL ONSLAUGHT AGAINST GERMANY WENT ON YESTERDAY, LAST NIGHT AND TODAY. YESTERDAY, OVER 5000 AMERICAN AND BRITISH PLANES FLYING FROM BASES IN ENGLAND AND ITALY AND ALLIED OCCUPIED COUNTRIES WERE OVER THE REICH. MORE THAN 2000 AMERICAN HEAVIES FROM BRITAIN AND ITALY BLASTED RAIL CENTERS IN WESTERN GER-MANY AND AN OIL REFINERY NEAR VIENNA. BRITISH HEAVIES AND MOSQUITOS IN DAYLIGHT YESTERDAY RIPPED OIL AND RAIL TARGETS IN THE RUHR. BRITISH AND AMERICAN FIGHTER AND MEDIUM BOMBERS WERE OUT OVER GERMANY AND HOLLAND YESTERDAY IN VERY GREAT STR-ENGTH. BRITISH TYPHOONS AND SPITFIRES DEMOLISHED ROCKET LAUNCHING STORAGE BUILD-INGS IN HOLLAND AND WESTERN GERMANY. LAST NIGHT, RAF MOSQUITOS HAMMERED HANNOVER AND HAMBURG. TODAY, MORE THAN 1250 YANK HEAVY BOMBERS ESCORTED BY 950 FIGHTERS PLASTERED THE OFTEN BOMBED LEUNA OIL PLANT NEAR MERCERS BURG IN GERMANY

#### KUSSIA:

POWERFUL KUSSIAN FORCES SPEARHEADED BY TANKS ARE CONVERGING ON BUDAPEST FROM 4 POINTS. SAVAGE HAND TO HAND FIGHTING IS GOING ON IN THE NORTHERN OUTSKIRTS OF THE HUNGARIAN CAPITAL. IN A NEW DRIVE FROM THE NORTHEAST, THE SOVILTS HAVE HAM-MERED TO WITHIN 10 MILES OF THE CITY. SOME 40 MILES NORTH OF BUDAPEST NEAR THE NORTHERN BEND OF THE DANUE IN HUNGARY, THE RUSSIANS HAVE DRIVEN ACROSS THE SOUTH-ENN BORDER OF CZECHOSLOVOKIA AND ARE STEADILY ADVANCING. IN ANOTHER DRIVE FOR SOUTHERN CZECHOSLOVOKIA, THE RUSSIANS HAVE TAKEN MORE TOWNS ABOVE MISKOLC IN NORTH-EASTERN HUNGARY.

# ITALY:

THERE HAS BEEN A FLAHE UP OF GERMAN AIR ACTIVITY OVER THE FIFTH ARMY FRONT IN ITALY. THE FIGHTING HAS DIED DOWN ON THE EIGHTH ARMY SECTOR NEAR FAENZA AFTER LARGE SCALE GERMAN COUNTERATTACKS OVER THE WEEKEND.

#### GREECE :

BRITISH FORCES IN ATHENS HAVE MADE MORE PROGRESS IN THE DOCK AREA OF THE CITY. THE REBELS HAVE FORCED THE BRITISH BACK IN THE CENTER OF THE GREEK CAPITAL. THE GUERIILAS ARE WELL SUPPLIED WITH SMALL ARMS AND AMAUNITION AND ARE HEAVILY SHELLING ATHENS WITH & FIELD GUNS. BRITISH REINFORCEMENTS ARE MOVING ON ATHENS. IN A WEEK OF FIGHTING THE LEFT WING GUERILLAS HAVE LOST 3000 MEN KILLED AND 2000 CAPTURED. TUEN PAGE

# PACIFIC:

AMERICAN FORCES THAT CAPTURED ORMOC ON LEYTE ISLAND WIPED OUT THE ENTIRE JAP GARRISON THERE AND CAPTURED HUGE STORES OF SUPPLIES. THE YANK 7TH AND 77TH INF-ANTRY DIVISIONS HAVE JOINED UP IN THE ORMOC AREA CUTTING OFF ANCTHER JAP FORCE. IN BURNA. THE BRITISH 36TH DIVISION IS CONSOLIDATING ITS GAINS ABOUND THE JAP

IN BUHMA, THE BRITISH JOTH DIVISION IS CONSOLIDATING ITS GAINS AROUND THE JAP FORWARD HASES OF INDAW AND KATHA. EAST AFRICAN TROOPS HAVE EXTENDED THEIR BRIDGE-HEAD AT KALEWA AND ARE DRIVING FOR THE IMPORTANT RAILWAY BETWEEN KALEWA AND MAN-DALAY. THE WEST AFRICAN BIST DIVISION HAS ADVANCED 25 MILES IN A WEEK IN NORTH-ERN. BURMA.
