BEIGIUM:

AMERICAN AND BRITISH FORCES UNDER FIELD MARSHALL MONTGOMERY ARE ATTACKING ON A 25 MILE FRONT ALONG THE NOLTHERN FLANK OF RUNDSTEDT'S SALIENT IN THE ARDENNES. BOTH THE YANKS AND THE BRITISH HAVE PUSHED AHEAD FOR AN AVERAGE GAIN OF FOUR MILES ALONG THE WHOLE FRONT. ONE FORCE CLOSING ON THE MAIN SUPPLY ROAD BETWEEN LA ROCHE AND ST VITH. THE AMERICANS ARE WITHIN A FEW THOUSAND YARDS OF THE HOAD ALONG A SEVEN MILE FRONT. THE YANKS WERE LAST REPORTED WITHIN 22 MILES OF LA HOUHE ITSELF. THE WEATHER ON THIS FRONT WAS BAD AGAIN TODAY KULING OUT DIRECT AIR SUPPORT. THE NAZIS ARE FIERCELY CONTESTING THE ALLIED ADVANCE ON THIS SECTOR AND MAKSHALL KUNDSTEDT HAS CONCENTRATED LARGE NUMBERS OF TANKS AND ARTILLERY IN THIS AREA. AMERICAN THIRD ARMY TROOPS HAVE BEEN FORCED TO DHOP BACK ABOUT TWO MILES NORTHEAST OF BASTOGNE BUT THE YANKS HAVE TAKEN ANOTHER TOWN DUE WEST OF BASTOGNE. THE CERMANS HAVE COUNTER-ATTACKED SIX TIMES IN THE PAST 24 HOURS IN THE BASTOGNE AREA BUT HAVE BEEN BEATEN BACK WITH HEAVY LOSSES EACH TIME. NEAR THE SAAR PALATINATE BORDER THE GERMANS HAVE DRIVEN A WEDGE 12 MILES DEEP INTO AMERICAN SEVENTH ARMY LINES. THIS WEDGE IS RETWEEN SAARGUEMINES AND HAGUENOT AND THE GERMANS HAVE REACHED THE MAIN ROAD BETWEEN THESE TWO TOWNS AND ARE ONLY IC MILES FROM THE SAVERNE GAP. AMERICAN SEVENTH ARMY FORCES HAVE STIFFENED HERE AND HAVE HELD THE CEHMANS. FURTHUR SOUTH, ABOUT 8 MILES ABOVE STRASBOURG, THE GERMANS HAVE CROSSED THE HHINE RIVER AND ARE FIGHTING IN TWO SMALL TOWNS ON THE WESTERN BANK OF THE RHINE.

THE LARGE SCAIE NIGHT AND DAY ABHIAL OFFENSIVE AGAINST GERMANY AND GERMAN TROOPS IN THE ARDENNES SALIENT WENT ON TODAY AND LAST NIGHT. TODAY MORE THAN 800 AMERICAN HEAVIES ESCORTED BY 550 FIGHTERS BOMEED ROAD AND HAIL BRIDGES ACROSS THE RHINE AT COLOGNE AND BONN. THE HEAVIES ALSO ATTACKED OTHER TARGETS IN WESTERN GERMANY. LAST NIGHT OVER 1000 RAF BOMEERS WERE OVER GERMANY. HAP HEAVIES STAGED A "DOUBLE ATTACK" ON HANNOVER AND AFTER THE ATTACKS GREAT FIRES COULD BE SEEN FOR 200 MILES. RAF MOSQUITOS WENT BACK TO FERLIN AGAIN LAST NIGHT WITH 4000 POUND BOMBS. EARLY THIS MORNING BEFORE DAYBREAK A FORCE OF RAF LANCASTERS PLASTERED GERMAN TROOP AND TANK CONCENTRATIONS AT HOUFFALIZE 10 MILES NORTHEAST OF BASTOGNE. HAF MOSQUITOS LAST NIGHT OUT OVER THE ARDENNES SALIENT BOMED THE COMMUNICATION CENTER OF ST VITH. ALL OF THE ROAD AND HAIL LINES LEADING INTO ST VITH HAVE NOW BEEN CUT. FROM THE NIGHT'S OPERATIONS 33 RAF BOMEERS ARE MISSING.

HUSSIA:

THE RUSSIANS STORMED ANOTHER 230 CITY BLOCKS AND TOOK MORE THAN 2000 PRISONERS IN THE FIGHTING IN BUDAPEST YESTERDAY. WEST OF THE HUNGARIAN CAPITOL THE REL ARMY HAS HEATEN BACK MORE POWERFUL GERMAN ATTEMPTS TO RELIEVE BUDAPEST.

RUSSIA HAS RECOGNIZED THE LUBLIN COMMITTEE AS THE PROVISIONAL GOVERNMENT OF POLAND. BRITAIN AND THE UNITED STATES CONTINUE TO RECOGNIZE THE POLISH GOVERNMENT IN IONTON.

ITALY:

CANADIAN THOOPS OF THE EIGHTH ARMY HAVE REACHED THE SOUTHERN SHORE OF LAKE COMACCHIO AND HAVE TAKEN THE TOWN OF ST ALBERTO. THE LAKE LIES NORTHWEST OF RAVENNA. ALLIED AIRCRAFT IN ITALY FIEW MORE THAN 600 SORTIES YESTERDAY.

GREECE:

OHGANIZED FIGHTING HAS CEASED IN ATHEMS AND THE PIRAEUS, THE PORT OF ATHEMS. BRITISH TROOPS RANGING IN NORTHERN ATHEMS, THE LAST AREA HELD BY ELAS, MET ONLY OCCASIONAL SNIPER FIRE.

PACIFIC:

AMERICAN SIXTH ARMY FORCES HAVE LANDED WITHOUT OPPOSITION ON THE PHILIPPINE ISLAND OF MARINDUQUE, LESS THAN 100 MILES FROM MANILA. AMERICAN HEAVY BOMBERS HAVE AGAIN ATTACKED CLARK AIRFIELD NEAR MANILA AND OTHER AMERICAN BOMBERS HAVE BOMBED THE VOICANO ISLANDS ABOUT 600 MILES FROM JAPAN.

AMERICAN SUPER FORTRESSES FLYING FROM ASIATIC BASES TODAY ATTACKED INDUSTRIES ON THE JAP HOME ISLAND OF KYUSHU. IN THE TWO DAY ATTACK ON FORMOSA ISLAND AND THE ISLAND OF OKINAWA, AMERICAN CARRIER PLANES DESTHOYED 111 JAP PLANES AND SUNK OR DAMAGED 95 JAP SHIPS.

BRITISH CARRIER PLANES HAVE BOMBED AN IMPORTANT JAP OIL REFINERY ON THE NORTH-

EAST COAST OF SUMATRA WITHOUT LOSS.
