RUSSIA:

ACCORDING TO THE GERMANS A MUSSIAN SPEAKHEAD HAS REACHED THE BALTIC COAST NEAR THE EAST PRUSSIAN TOWN OF ELBING THEREBY CUTTING OFF THE GERMANS IN THE LASTERN PART OF THE COUNTRY. THE GERMANS ALSO SAY THAT MARSHALL KONEV'S FORCES IN GERMAN SILESIA HAVE BRIDGED THE RIVER ODER AFTER TAKING THE CITY OF OPPEIN. MUSCOW SAYS THAT THE RUSSIANS HAVE REACHED THE OUTER DEFENSES OF THE EAST PRUSSIAN CAPITOL OF KOENIGSBERG AND IN SILESIA HAVE STARTED THE ASSAULT ON ERESLAU. A SIXTH RED ARMY HAS JOINED THE SOVIET SWEEP TO THE WEST.

THE GELMAN OVERSEAS NEW AGENCY SAID TODAY THAT A RUSSIAN SPEARHEAD, PRESUMABLY TROOPS OF MARSHALL ROKOSSOVOSKY'S FIRST WHITE RUSSIAN ARMY; HAD REACHED THE BALTIC COAST NORTHEAST OF ELEING AND SAID THAT THE GERMANS FIGHTING IN EAST PRUSSIA HAD BEEN, AT LEAST TEMPORARILY, CUT OFF. ROKOSSOVOSKY'S FORCES LAST NIGHT WERE REPORTED 17 MILES FROM ELEING. IN EASTERN EAST PRUSSIA, THIRD WHITE RUSSIAN ARMY TROOPS UN-DER GENERAL CHERNY. KHOVSKY WERE REPORTED TO HAVE REACHED THE FIRST LINE OF DEFENSES BEFORE KOENIGS BERG. THE REDS HAD THROWN BACK 14 ARMORED COUNTER ATTACKS BY THE SAV-AGELY RESISTING NAZIS AND WERE MASSING TO ASSAULT THE CITY.

IN WESTERN POLAND, MARSHALL ZHUKOV'S WHITE RUSSIAN TROOPS YESTERDAY STORMED THE CITY OF KALISZ, 25 MILES FROM THE PORDER OF NORTHERN SILESIA AND 60 MILES FROM BRES-LAU. THE GERMANS TODAY REPORTED THAT ZHUKOV'S MEN WERE ATTACKING THE BIG CITY OF POZNAN.

MARSHALL IVAN KONEV'S FIRST UKHANIAN ARMY IS NOW FIGHTING IN GERMAN SILESIA ON A 100 MILE FRONT. KONEV IS GRINDING AREAD BOTH NORTH AND SOUTH OF BRESLAU. MOS-COW SAYS THAT RUSSIAN FORCES HAVE AIREADY BEGUN THE ASSAULT ON BRESLAU AFTER THE NAZIS DECLARED IT TO BE A FORTRESS AND SAID IT WOULD BE DEFENDED TO THE LAST. DOWN THE ODER RIVER FROM BRESLAU KONEV'S FORCES HAVE STORMED THE CITY OF OPPEIN AND THE GERMANS SAID TODAY THAT THE RUSSIANS HAD & BRIDGEHEAD ACHOSS THE ODER AT OPPEIN.

GEHMANS SAID TODAY THAT THE RUSSIANS HAD & BRIDGEHEAD ACROSS THE ODER AT OPPEIN. MARSHALL STALIN ANNOUNCED LAST NIGHT THAT A SIXTH RUSSIAN ARMY, THE SECOND UK-RANIAN, UNDER MARSHALL RODION Y. MALINOVSKY HAD JOINED IN THE GREAT WINTER OFFENSIVE. MALINOVSKY'S TROOPS ATTACKING ALONG A 25 MILE FRONT IN THE RUGGED COUNTRY OF LOWER CZECHOSLOVOKIA ABOUT 100 MILES NORTHEAST OF BUDAPEST, HAVE SMASHED STRONG GERMAN DEFENSES AND PUSHED AREAD FOR A DOZEN MILES.

THE GERMANS HAVE AGAIN SUFFERED HEAVILY IN VAIN ATTEMPTS TO RELIEVE THEIR BUD-

BEIGIUM:

THE GERMANS HAVE LAUNCHED THEIR LONG AWAITED ATTACK AGAINST THE GALARICAN SEVENTH ARMY. THE NAZIS ARE ATTACKING ALONG A 20 MILE FRONT RUNNING FROM THE HAGUENAU FOR-EST DOWN TO THE LOWER VOSGES. THE HEAVIEST FIGHTING IS GOING ON ABOUND THE CITY OF HAGUENAU. THE GERMANS ATTACKED AFTER A ARTILLERY AND MORTAR BARRAGE AND HAVE MADE SOME GAINS.

IN THE ARDENNES AMERICAN THIRD ARMY FORCES LAST NIGHT WERE REPORTED 4 MILES FROM THE GERMAN BORDER. RUNDSTEDT ATTEMPTED TO PULL HIS ARMOR AND TROOPS BACK INTO THE SIEGFRIED LINE AGAIN YESTERDAY. AMERICAN FIGHTER BOMBERS DESTROYED SEVERAL HUNDRED MORE NAZI TRUCKS MOVING EASTWARD. BRITISH TACTICAL PLANES YESTERDAY RIPPED GERMAN MILITARY TRAFFIC AROUND MUNSTER AND OSNA BRUCK IN GERMANY. THEY CAUGHT 63 HIG TRAINS MOVING IN DAYLIGHT AND HEAVILY ATTACKED THEM. IN THREE DAYS, BRITISH PLANES HAVE KNOCKED OUT 230 LOCOMOTIVES AND HUNDREDS OF CARS.

BELGIUM CONTINUED:

FRINCH FIRST ARMY TROOPS ATTACKING BOTH FLANKS OF THE COLMAR SALLENT HAVE MADE GOOD GAINS. ON THE NORTHERN FLANK THE FRENCH HAVE ADVANCED 3 MILES ON A 10 MILE FRONT AND HAVE CROSSED A RIVER SEVERAL MILES FROM COLMAR.

BRITISH SECOND ARMY TROOPS IN THEIR DRIVE FOR THE ROER VALLEY IN GERMANY HAVE PUSHED TO WITHIN 3 MILES OF ROERMOND WHERE THE MAAS AND ROER RIVERS MEET.

PACIFIC:

AMERICAN TROOPS ON 1UZON ISLAND HAVE TAKEN ONE OF THE OUTER GROUP OF CLARK AIR-FIELDS ABOUT 45 MILES FROM MANILA. AMERICAN HEAVY BOMBERS HAVE ATTACKED CORREG-IDOR ISLAND FOR THE FIRST TIME.

IN BURMA THE JAPS HAVE HEAVILY SHELLED THE BRITISH BRIDGEHEAD ACKOSS THE INKA-WADDY RIVER ABOUT 40 MILES UPSTREAM FROM MANDALAY. THE TOKIO RADIO REPORTED TODAY THAT BRITISH CARLIER PLANES WERE ATTACKING TARGETS ON SUMATHA.
