RUSSIA:

MARSHALL ZHUKOV'S WHITE HUSSIAN TROOPS ARE REPORTED BY THE GERMANS TO BE OPER-ATING ON THE WEST BANK OF THE ODER NEAR KUSTEIN. THE GERMAN HADIO REPORTS THAT ZHUKOV'S INFANTRYMEN ARE SAVAGELY ATTACKING IN THE KUSTEIN AREA AND THAT THE HEDS ARE THYING TO ENCIRCIE THE CITY. THE GERMANS CLAIM THAT ZHUKOV HAS ESTABLISHED A NUMBER OF BRIDGEHEADS ACROSS WIDE STRETCHES OF THE MIDDLE ODER EAST OF BELLIN. MOSCOW HAS SAID NOTHING ABOUT THESE REPORTED BRIDGE HEADS. SOVIET ARTILLERY MASSED ALONG THE EASTERN BANK OF THE ODER HAS BEEN POUNDING GERMAN POSITIONS ON THE FAR BANK WITHOUT LETUP FOR THE PAST THREE DAYS. ZHUKOV'S RIGHT WING HAS PUSHED NEARER TO THE BALTIC PORT OF STETTIN ON A 20 MILE FRONT. HUSSIAN GAVALRY AND INFANTRY WERE REPORTED BY THE GERMANS TODAY TO BE WITHIN SHELLING DISTANCE OF THE TOWN OF STARGARD, 20 MILES EAST OF STETTIN. IN YESTERDAY'S FIGHTING ON THIS FRONT THE HEDS DESTROYED 84 TANKS AND DROVE TO WITHIN 15 MILES OF THE TRUNK RAIL LINE BE-TWEEN STETTIN AND THE PORT OF DANZIG.

MARSHALL KONEV'S FIRST UKKANIAN ARMY IS REPORTED BY BERLIN TO HOLD BRIDGEREADS ON BOTH SIDES OF BRESLAU ON THE UPPER ODER RIVER. KONEV'S 50 MILE WIDE BRIDGEHEAD SOUTH OF BRESLAU HAS BEEN FURTHUR EXPANDED AND DEEPENED. THE GERMANS REPORT THAT THE RUSSIANS NOW HOLD ANOTHER BRIDGERE AD NORTHWEST OF BRESLAU NEAR THE BIG TOWN OF STEIN AU AND SAY THAT THE RUSSIANS HAVE LAUNCHED AN OFFENSIVE FROM THIS NEW BEIDGE HE AD. BEESLAU ITSELF IS NOW THREATENED FROM THREE SIDES.

IN EAST PRUSSIA, MARSHALL ROKOSSOVOSKY'S SECOND WHITE RUSSIAN ARMY HAS COMPIETED THE ENCIRCIEMENT OF THE TOWN OF ELBING NEAR THE BALTIC COAST. SOUTH OF KOEN-IGS ELAG, THE TOWN OF KREUZEERG HAS BEEN TAKEN.

CANADIAN AND UNITED KINGDOM TROOPS OF THE CANADIAN FIRST ARMY HAVE LAUNGHED A NEW ATTACK SOUTHEAST OF NIJMEGEN ON A 6-7 MILE FRONT. THE ATTACK WAS PRECEDED BY A 5½ HOUR ARTILLERY BARRAGE AND BY AN AIR ASSAULT. THIS AFTERNOON, THE ALLIED TROOPS WERE REPORTED TO HAVE ADVANCED UP TO 4½ MILES AT SOME PLACES INTO THE FIRST OF THE THREE BELTS IN THE SIEGFRIED LINE IN THE REICHSWALD FOREST. CANADIANS AND BRITISH FORCES WERE SURPRISED TO FIND THAT THE FIRST BELT IN THE SIEGFRIED LINE WAS NOT MADE UP OF CONCRETE FORTS. GERMAN RESISTANCE SO FAR HAS

NOT BEEN HEAVY AND 1200 PRISONERS HAVE BEEN TAKEN.

AMERICAN FIRST ARMY TROOPS BATTLING THROUGH THE HURTGEN FOREST EAST OF MON-SCHAU WERE LAST REPORTED WITHIN A MILE OF THE BIGGEST OF THE DAWS ON THE ROLL FIVER. GENERAL PATTON'S THIRD ARMY TROOPS HAVE PUSHED TO LESS THAN A MILE FROM THE ROAD JUNCTION OF PRUM IN THE SIEGFRIED LINE. ACROSS FROM THE LUXEMBOURG BOR-DER, OTHER THIRD ARMY FORCES HAVE CONSOLIDATED THEIR 10 BRIDGER ADS ACROSS THE HIVERS OUR AND SURE. IN SOUTHERN ALSACE, ALL ORGANIZED RESISTANCE IN THE GERMAN BRIDGEHE AD SOUTH OF STRASBOURG HAS ENDED. THERE ARE STILL SOME GERMANS LEFT ON THE WESTERN BANK OF THE LHINE BUT THEY HAVE BLOWN THE BRIDGES ACROSS THE RIVER.

A GREAT AERIAL FIRET OF MORE THAN 1300 U. S. HEAVY BOMBERS TODAY WERE OVER WIDE PARTS OF CERMANY. THE BOMBERS MAULED A BIG MARSHALLING YARD AT MAGDEBURG, A SYNTHETIC OIL PLANT WEST OF IEIPSIG AND AN ARMS FACTORY. DURING THE NIGHT, MORE THAN 1000 RAF BOMBERS BLASTED TARGETS IN THE REICH. A GREAT SYNTHETIC CIL PLANT AT POLITZ, NEAR STETTIN, AND ONLY 46 MILES FROM THE RUSSIAN LINES, WAS PLASTERED TWICE BY RAF HEAVIES. A FORCE OF MOSQUITOS DROPPED IN ON BEALIN AND TWO SEPARATE FORCES OF HEAVIES HIT A SYNTHETIC PLANT AND A RAIL YARD IN THE RUHR. IN DAYLIGHT YESTERDAY, ALLIED TACTICAL PLANES FIRM SOME 1500 SORTIES AGAINST A WIDE VARIETY OF TARGETS IN WESTERN GERMANY.

FIFTH RMY TROOPS HAVE MADE MORE GAINS IN THE SEACHIO VALLEY AND IN THE HILLS SOUTHEAST OF BOLOGNA. AMERICAN HEAVY BOMBERS FROM ITALY YESTERDAY ATTACKED COM-MINICATIONS IN THE VIENNA AREA OF AUSTRIA.

BRITISH TROOPS OF THE 14 PH ARMY IN CENTRAL BURMA ARE REPORTED TO BE FIGHTING IN THE CENTER OF THE BURMA OIL AREA TO THE SOUTH OF MANDALAY. THIS IS THE DEEPEST PENETRATION REPORTED IN BURMA AS YET. ABOUT 40 MILES NORTH OF MANDALAY, OTHER BRITISH TROOPS HAVE WIDENED THEIR BRIDGEHEAD OVER THE IRRAWADDY RIVER.

THE AMERICAN 37TH INFANTRY AND 11TH AIRBORNE DIVISIONS ARE SQUEEZING THE LAST OF THE JAPS HOLDING OUT IN MANILA. THE JAPS ARE REPORTED TO BE DESTROYING PARTS

OF THE CITY AS THEY FALL BACK.
