

DCN'T FRATERNIZE! DON'T TRUST A GERMAN

GERMANY:

TROOPS OF THE AMERICAN NINTH, THE BRITISH SECOND AND CANADIAN FIRST ARMIES HAVE CROSSED THE LOWER RHINE RIVER IN A MAJOR OFFENSIVE. THE CROSSINGS WERE MADE DURING THE NIGHT AND EARLY THIS MORNING AND WERE PRECEDED BY A TREMENDOUS ARTILLERY BARRAGE THAT SAW AMERICAN AND BRITISH CANNON FIRING FOR THREE HOURS WITHOUT A PAUSE. AFTER DAWN THIS MORNING, UNITS OF THE FIRST ALLIED AIRBORNE ARMIES, INCLUDING THE SIXTH BRITISH AIRBORNE DIVISION AND THE AMERICAN LOIST AIRBORNE DIVISION, DROPPED JUST BEHIND THE GERMAN FORCES ON THE EAST BANK. THOSE TROOPS WHO CROSSED THE RIVER IN ASSAULT CRAFT MET LIGHT OPPOSITION ON THE OTHER SIDE AND SOME UNITS WERE LAST REPORTED TO HAVE DRIVEN 2 MILES BEYOND THE FAR BANK.

AT SIX O'CLCCK LAST NIGHT, THE AMERICAN AND BRITISH ARTILLERY POURED A HAIL

OF STEEL ACROSS THE RIVER FOR THREE HOURS WITHOUT LETUP. AT NINE O'CLCCK, BY THE

LIGHT OF THE MOCN, UNITED KINGDOM FORCES WENT INTO ACTION. HUGE NAVAL CRAFT OP—

ERATED BY PERSONNEL OF THE ROYAL NAVY, WERE LOADED WITH TROOPS OF THE 51ST HIGH—

LAND DIVISION AND THESE TROOPS WERE CARRIED ACROSS THE RHINE ABOUT 12 MILES BE—

LOW WESEL.

AT TEN O'CLCCK LAST NIGHT, BELTISH COMMANDOS SLIPPED ACROSS THE RIVER JUST DOWNSTREAM FROM WESEL. JUST AFTER THE COMMANDOS HAD REACHED THE FAR BANK OF THE RIVER, RAF HEAVY BOMBERS FLEW OVER TO PLASTER THE DEFENSES OF WESEL. AS SOON AS THE BOMBING HAD CEASED, THE COMMANDOS SLIPPED INTO THE TOWN AND TOOK IT. JUST ABOUT THREE O'CLOCK THIS MORNING, THE 15TH SCOTTISH DIVISION CROSSED THE RIVER FROM NEAR XANTEN.

UNITS OF THE AMERICAN NINTH ARMY WENT INTO ACTION AT FOUR O'CLOCK THIS MORNING ON THE OTHER SIDE OF WESEL FURTHUR UPSTREAM. THE YANKS PILED INTO HUGE ASSAULT CRAFT OPERATED BY MEN OF THE UNITED STATES NAVY AND THEY QUICKLY GROSSED THE RIVER AND PUSHED ON. EARLY THIS MORNING THE AMERICAN LOIST AIRBORNE, THE HEROS OF BASTOGNE, AND THE BRITISH SIXTH AIRDER. DIVISION WERE DROPPED JUST BEHIND THE GERMAN FORCES ON THE EAST BANK OF THE RIVER. CORRESPONDENTS SAY THAT 1500 TRANSPORT PLANES AND GLIDERS WERE USED IN THE MASSIVE AIRBORNE OPERATION. AMERICAN LIBERATORS HAVE AIRBORDE UNITS.

ICAN LIBERATORS HAVE ALKEADY DROPPED SID TIES TO THE ALKBORNE UNITS.

GERMAN RESISTANCE ON THE EAST BANK OF THE RHINE KIVER IS REPORTED TO BE "LIGHT"
BUT THE ALLIED TROOPS HAVE NOT YET KUN INTO THE GERMAN RESERVES.

ANOTHER ALLIED ARMY, THE UNITED STATES THIRD ARMY, UNDER LT. GENERAL S PATTON, HAS CROSSED THE RHINE REPORTED TO BE THURSDAY NIGHT WITHOUT ARTILIERY OR AIR PREPARATION AND THEY ARE REPORTED TO BE AIREADY ENLARGING THEIR BRIDGEREAD AND SHUTTLING TROOPS AND SUPPLIES ACROSS IN FERRIES AND ASSAULT BOATS. IT HAS NOT BEEN REPORTED YET WHERE THE THIRD ARMY CROSSING TOOK PLACE BUT THE GERMANS SAY THAT THE AMERICANS CROSSED NEAR OPPONHEIM ABOUT 100 MILES UPSTREAM FROM REMAGEN. THE GERMAN REMNANTS LEFT WEST OF THE RHINE, ESTIMATED AT 20,000 MEN, ARE IN A VERY BAD WAY AFTER LOSING THEIR LAST ESCAPE BRIDGE WHEN THIRD ARMY YANKS TOOK SPEYER. THE CITY OF LUDWIGSHAFEN HAS BEEN CLEARED AND SOUTH OF THIS CITY THE NAZIS HAVE BEEN COMPRESSED INTO A POCKET 10 MILES DEEP.

THE ALL-OUT ALLIED AERIAL OFFENSIVE AGAINST THE REICH WENT ON AGAIN TODAY.

MORE THAN 1000 AMERICAN HEAVIES BLASTED 12 MORE GERMAN AIRFIELDS ABOUT 60 MILES
BEHIND THE FRONT LINES EAST OF THE LOWER RHINE, A FORCE OF 850 FIGHTERS ESCORTED
THE BOMBERS AND THEY WENT ON ARMED PATROLS OVER NORTHWEST GERMANY. ALLIED TACTICAL PLANES WERE OUT IN VERY GREAT STRENGTH AGAIN TODAY HAMMERING AT TARGETS IN
THE RUHB AND IN NORTHERN GERMANY. WATCHERS ON THE ENGLISH COAST SAID THAT THEY
HAVE NEVER SEEN SUCH GREAT CONCENTRATIONS OF AIRCRAFT HEADING FOR GERMANY AS THEY
HAVE SEEN TODAY.

GEFMANT CONTINUED:

TCDAY MARKED THE FOURTH DAY OF MASSIVE ALLIED AIR BLOWS AGAINST THE REICH.

ALL TO AIRMEN HAVE PARALIZED COMMUNICATIONS IN THE RUHR VALLEY AND IN NORTH AND

CENTRAL GERMANY AND HAVE CREATED UTTER DEVASTATION WHERE RESSELKING IS TRYING

TO ASSEMBLE HIS FORCES TO TRY AND STOP MONTGOMERY.

AMERICAN HEAVY BOMBERS FROM ITALY TODAY FILW ALL THE WAY TO BERLIN TO POUND THAT CITY FOR THE FIRST TIME. THIS WAS THE LONGEST ESCORTED MISSION EVER FLOWN BY AMERICAN BOMBERS OF THE 15TH AIR FORCE. ALLIED PLANES FLEW SOME 2700 SORTIES YESTERDAY. MORE THAN 1000 MEDIUM BOMBERS ALONE YESTERDAY ATTACKED COMMUNICATIONS IN AUSTRIA AND NORTHERN ITALY.

RUSSIA:

MARSHALL KONEV'S MEN IN UPPER SILESIA HAVE BROADENED THEIR SOUTHWARD DRIVE AND ARE DRIVING TO BURST THROUGH THE SUDETEN GAP GUARDING THE APPROACHES TO PRAGUE. KONEV'S MEN HAVE TAKEN MORE PLACES ON AND NEAR THE CZECHOSLOVAK FRONTIER AND HAVE CUT THE MAIN GERMAN SUPPLY ROUTE TO THE MORAVIAN GAP AND NOW THREATEN THIS HISTORIC PASS THAT LEADS THROUGH CZECHOSLOVOKIA TO VIENNA. THE GERMANS SAY THAT KONEV'S TANKS ARE FIGHTING IN THE TOWN OF NEISSE

MARSHALL ROKOSSOVOSKY'S FORCES HAVE DRIVEN TO THE BALTIC BETWEEN DANZIG AND GDYNIA AND HAVE TAKEN THE PORT OF ROPPOT. THIS DRIVE HAS SPLIT THE GERMAN POCKET IN TWO. THE CERMANS SAY THAT MARSHALL AND COLY 33 MILES FROM THE GERMAN CAPLITOL.

PACIFIC:

BRITISH 14TH ARMY TROOPS HAVE ADVANCED FAR SOUTH OF MANDALAY TO WITHIN 18 MILES OF BEIKTILA. THE JAPS ON THE MANDALAY PLAIN IN BETWEEN THE BRITISH FORCES. HAVE LOST THE IRRAWADDY RIVER TOWN OF MYINGYAN.

SEVEN HUNDRED (700) JAPANESE AIRCRAFT WERE DESTROYED OR DAMAGED IN THIS WEEK'S CARRIER BORNE ATTACKS ON JAPAN. THE AMERICAN ESCORT CARRIER, "BISMARCK SEA", WAS LOST OFF IWO JIMA LAST MONTH. TOKIO RADIO SAID TODAY THAT AMERICAN CARRIER PLANES WERE ATTACKING THE RYUKU CHAIN OF ISLANDS SOUTH OF JAPAN.
