GERMANY:

IN DEFIANCE OF THE UNCONDITIONAL SURRENDER TERMS GERMAN PLANES TODAY BOMBED PRAGUE AND SEVERAL SMALL TOWNS NEAR PRAGUE. ONE TOWN, MEINIK, WAS BOMBED SEVERAL TIMES AND THE CZECH RADIO CALLED ON ALLIED DIVE BOMBERS TO GO TO MEINIK TO ATTACK GERMAN TROOPS WHO WERE SHOOTING UP THE CIVIL POPULATION THERE. THE ALL CLEAR HAS SOUNDED IN PRAGUE. PRAGUE RADIO HAS REPORTED THAT RUSSIAN TANKS HAVE PUSHED INTO PRAGUE AFTER OVERCOMING SOME GERMAN RESISTANCE IN THE OUTSKIRTS.

GERMANY'S UNCONDITIONAL SURRENDER WAS RATIFIED IN BERLIN LAST NIGHT. IT WAS SIGNED FOR THE ALLIES BY MARSHALL ZHUKOV AND AIR CHIEF MARSHALL TEDDER AND FOR GERMANY BY FIELD MARSHALL KEITEL AND 2 OTHER SENIOR GERMAN OFFICERS. THE RAF FLEW THE GERMAN DELEGATION TO BERLIN AND THEN BACK TO THE GERMAN HEADQUARTERS AT FLENSBURG ON THE GERMAN-DENMARK BORDER.

IN NORWAY, QUISLING HAS BEEN ARRESTED AND INTERNED. NORWEGIAN TROOPS ARE REPORTED TO HAVE OCCUPIED THE NORTHERN PART OF NORWAY. BRITISH WARSHIPS ARRIVED OFF COPENHAGEN TODAY TO ACCEPT THE SURRENDER OF THE GERMANS LEFT IN DENMARK. FRENCH TROOPS MARCHED INTO THE ATLANTIC PORTS OF LA ROCHELLE, LORIENT AND SAINT NAZAIRE TODAY. THE GERMANS IN THE DODOCANESE ISLANDS HAVE COMPLETED CAPITULATION TO BRITISH FORCES. ALLIED REPRESENTATIVES OF SCOTTISH COMMAND HAVE ARRIVED IN NORWAY TO DISCUSS SURRENDER TERMS. IN MOSCOW, THE RUSSIANS ARE CELEBRATING "VE" DAY TODAY AND IN YUGOSLAVIA, MARSHALL TITO HAS DECLARED TODAY A NATIONAL HOLIDAY.

THE "GENERAL CATCHING" AMERICAN SEVENTH ARMY PICKED UP TWO MORE NOTABLES TODAY. FIELD MARSHALL GOERING AND FIELD MARSHALL KESSELIKING JOINED THE SEVENTH ARMY'S BAG OF PRISONERS. GOERING SAID THAT HE HAD BEEN IN THE AREA OF HIS CAPTURE SINCE MARCH WHEN HITLER HAD SENTENCED HIM TO DEATH.

BRITAIN WILL EMPLOY GERMAN PRISONERS OF WAR IN CONSIDERABLE NUMBERS IN HER RECONSTRUCTION PROGRAM.

PACIFIC:

BRITISH 14TH ARMY TROOPS ARE PUSHING OUT IN ALL DIRECTIONS FROM RANGOON. BOATLOADS OF JAP TROOPS TRYING TO ESCAPE OVER THE IRRAWADDY RIVER HAVE BEEN AMBUSHED AND SUNK. AUSTRALIAN TROOPS ON THE BORNEO ISLAND OF TARAkan ARE WITHIN 2 MILES OF AN IMPORTANT AIRFIELD.

AMERICAN WARSHIPS HAVE CONTINUED TO POUND POSITIONS IN SOUTHERN OKINAWA AND GROUND TROOPS ARE THREATENING THE ISLAND'S CAPITOL, NAHA. YANKS ON MINDANAO ARE MEETING STIFF RESISTANCE AROUND LIBERATED DAVAO. THE JAP NEWS AGENCY SAYS THAT AMERICAN SUPER FORTS YESTERDAY ATTACKED KYUSHYU AND SHIKOKU. AMERICAN PLANES HAVE SUNK 14,000 TCNS OF JAP SHIPPING IN KOREAN WATERS.
