PACIFIC:

VERY SAVAGE FIGHTING HAS CONTINUED ALL ALONG THE WHOLE OF THE SOUTHERN PART OF OKINAWA. THE FIGHTING FOR "SUGAR LOAF" HILL HAS BEEN PARTICULARLY BLOODY. THIS HILL THAT IS JUST IN FRONT OF NAHA, THE CAPITOL OF OKINAWA, HAS CHANGED HANDS 5 TIMES AND AT LAST REPORTS U. S. MARINES WERE PERCHED ON ITS SUMMIT. SO FAR THE JAPANESE HAVE LOST MORE THAN 48,000 KILLED ON OKINAWA. AMERICAN CASUALTIES SINCE THE MIDDLE OF MARCH ARE 8310 KILLED AND MISSING AND SOME 22,000 WOUNDED. NEARLY HALF THE AMERICAN CASUALTIES WERE NAVY MEN. THERE HAS BEEN BLOODY FIGHTING ON NEW GUINEA TOO WHERE AUSTRALIAN TROOPS HAVE TAKEN A CAPE FLANKING WEWAK HARBOR. AUSTRALIAN TROOPS HAVE GAINED CONTROL OF 1/3 OF BOUGANVILLE SINCE THEY TOOK OVER FROM THE AMERICANS 7 MONTHS AGO. AMERICAN TROOPS ON LUZON ARE MOPPING UP A BIG JAP FORCE THAT HAS BEEN ENCIRCLED.

AMERICAN LONG RANGE BOMBERS FROM THE PHILIPPINES HAVE ATTACKED FORMOSA. OTHER YANK BOMBERS HAVE BOMBED JAP SHIPPING IN THE CHINA SEA AND ALONG THE YANGTZE RIVER IN CHINA. CHUNGKING ANNOUNCES THAT CHINESE TROOPS HAVE BEATEN BACK A JAP OFFENSIVE 400 MILES NORTHEAST OF CHUNGKING. CHINESE TROOPS HAVE FLUNG THE JAPS OUT OF THE PORT OF FOOCOW ACROSS FROM FORMOSA. BRITISH 14TH ARMY MEN ARE STEADILY MOPPING UP MORE JAP POCKETS OF RESISTANCE.

EUROPE:

IN WASHINGTON THE ACTING SECRETARY OF STATE, MR. JOSEPH GREW, HAS STATED THAT MARSHALL TITO HAS GIVEN AN UNSATISFACTORY REPLY TO THE AMERICAN AND BRITISH NOTES ON TRIESTE. MR. GREW SAID THAT TITO'S NOTE REPEATED YUGOSLAVIA'S TERRITORIAL CLAIMS AND HE ADDED THAT THE SITUATION IN TRIESTE WAS BEING STILL FURTHER COMPLICATED BY THE INFILTRATION OF YUGOSLAV PARTISANS INTO THE REGION AROUND TRIESTE. TITO SAID IN A RADIO BROADCAST THAT HE IS READY TO COOPERATE WITH THE ALLIES AND WITH THE ALLIED FORCES BUT THAT YUGOSLAVIA "COULD NOT BE TRICKED OF HER RIGHTS."

CONSULTATIONS ARE NOW GOING ON BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES, BRITAIN, RUSSIA, YUGOSLAVIA AND ITALY CONCERNING THE TRIESTE PROBLEM.

SO FAR, 41 GERMAN U BOATS HAVE SURRENDER IN BRITISH WATERS. FIFTEEN OF THEM WERE YESTERDAY REPORTED ON THEIR WAY TO SCOTLAND TO GIVE THEMSELVES UP.

ODDS 'N ENDS:

LT. GENERAL SIMON BOLIVAR BUCKNER JR. IS THE HEAD OF THE AMERICAN 10TH ARMY NOW ENGAGED IN BLOODY FIGHTING ON OKINAWA. THE XXIV U.S. ARMY CORPS UNDER MAJ. GENERAL JOHN HODGE AND THE III MARINE AMPHIBIOUS CORPS UNDER MAJ. GENERAL ROY GEIGER MAKE UP THE U. S. 10TH ARMY.

THE AMERICAN 7TH, 27TH AND 96TH INFANTRY DIVISIONS HAVE BEEN REPORTED AS BEING IN THE ARMY'S XXIV CORPS. THE ONLY ANNOUNCED DIVISION IN THE III MARINE AMPHIBIOUS CORPS IS THE VETERAN FIRST MARINE DIVISION OF GUADACANAL FAME.

THE ANCHOR OF THE JAP DEFENSE LINE IN SOUTHERN OKINAWA IS THE MEDIEVAL ROCK FORTRESS OF SHURI. THIS PIVOT OF THE ENEMY LINE IS GUARDED BY MOATS AND WILL PROVE A TOUGH NUT TO CRACK.
